- ☑ Some data is too sensitive to leave on in house legacy equipment so make sure your provider has dedicated hardware options for private cloud and DRaaS use.

- ☑ Find a company that has managed services offerings with a 24x7 help desk.


- ☑ Ensure there is an easy to use and manage customer portal for management and resource allocation.

- ☑ Confirm that any IaaS provider you are considering has comprehensive, integrated security.

- ☑ Look for a company who has worked in the data center space and can advise you on both on premise infrastructure and cloud options.
